LIFE GROUP DISCUSSION

1. What was the Scripture, statement, or principle that hit you right between the eyes, and brought you to the mat today?

2. There were seven key admonitions we talked about today from Romans 13:11-14. Review them from the list below, and identify the one in which the Holy Spirit was specifically telling you He wants you to Man Up or Woman Up.
 - 1) Wise Up- *Know the time!*
 - 2) Wake Up- *Awake out of sleep!*
 - 3) Clean Up- *Cast off the works of darkness!*
 - 4) Dress Up- *Put on the armor of light!*
 - 5) Step Up- *Walk honestly!*
 - 6) Grow Up- *Put on the Lord Jesus Christ!*
 - 7) Close Up- *Make no provision for the flesh!*

3. We learned three things from this passage about what time it is from God's vantage point.
 - It is night time.
 - It is almost day time.

6. We looked at a list of eight things in Colossians 3:12-14, that define what it is to "Put on the Lord Jesus Christ." It is to "put on" bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering, forbearance, forgiveness, and above all these, charity, or love.
 - a. Based on those eight qualities, would your spouse, your children, or your roommate testify that you have "put on Christ?"

 - b. Based on those eight qualities, would your co-workers say that you have "put on Christ?"

7. Based on the admonition at the end of today's passage, "...and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof" (Romans 13:14), are there specific changes you need to make in your life to actually heed that admonition?
