Psalm 126:5,6

The Mission

WIN people to faith in Jesus Christ; **BUILD** them up in their faith; then **SEND** them out to be "winners and builders" in their spheres of influence.

1. It takes a calculated _____.

A. We must purposefully _____.

There isn't a verse in the entire Bible that commands a lost person to come to church. But there is verse after verse in God's Word that commands the Church to go to those who are lost.

B. We must continually _____.

Note: "Bearing seed for sowing," when literally translated, means "leaving a _____ of seed."

There is only one purpose in seed...it is to be sown. Seed is absolutely useless if it's not sown. We are to take every opportunity that God places in our path, to drop the seed of the Gospel in somebody's heart. Then, God does the rest of the work.

2. It takes a compassionate _____.

3. It takes a conscious _____.

One of the highest forms of worship we can give to God is when we share the Gospel of Jesus Christ and try to bring people into God's forever family. God promises a unique blessing to whoever will worship Him by obeying Him in simply planting the seed of the Gospel in the fertile fields of the lost.
